From the Pastor's Desk

Whether you are an avid sports fan, or lover of the arts, we all have in common the anticipation of the first pitch, opening kick-off, drop of the puck, the tip-off, the first strike of an orchestra's note, the opening lines of a play that hook us, or the drop of the green flag. Why do we have such great anticipation? Well...I cannot help but believe that a large portion of it is the excitement of what is about to take place, the clean slate where anything can happen, the opportunity to succeed/do better, the chance to win or be blessed with a sense of fulfillment of "this is what I have been waiting for," something new.

With all of this in mind, it reminds that here we are in 2023, a year that from my childhood seemed very *space age* (even though there are no flying cars that we are aware of.) There are incredible technologies that have come to be. But, here it is January 2023, the first day, week, weekend, month, of a new year to seek as the wisemen (*Matthew 2:1-12*) did, a new opportunity to be closer to God personally, as a family, a part of the 'body of Christ (the Church)', and as a community of believers that extend beyond any human-built walls (physical/social).

With this thought, I am reminded of Paul speaking to the Romans (Romans 12:1-8, NIV, 2011):

Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will.

³ For by the grace given me I say to every one of you: Do not think of yourself more highly than you ought, but rather think of yourself with sober judgment, in accordance with the faith God has distributed to each of you. ⁴ For just as each of us has one body with many members, and these members do not all have the same function, ⁵ so in Christ we, though many, form one body, and each member belongs to all the others. ⁶ We have different gifts, according to the grace given to each of us. If your gift is prophesying, then prophesy in accordance with your faith; ⁷ if it is serving, then serve; if it is teaching, then teach; ⁸ if it is to encourage, then give encouragement; if it is giving, then give generously; if it is to lead, do it diligently; if it is to show mercy, do it cheerfully.

As Paul, through the power of the Holy Spirit speaks to us, the Lord's Church, that with the anticipation of something new we should open ourselves to be governed by the things of God and no longer the things of this world. Why? Because this is where a true new life begins; a life not of this world but of the world that is to come. The things of this world will perish but not the things of God. Conformity leads to death and transformation leads to life. All of this is given by God's Grace.

So, with much anticipation, I hope that your 2023 is blessed. I hope and pray that we are all able, with great anticipation, to be ready to transform and grow closer to God to more fully receive and share His Blessings with all the world.

A Christ-Centered Grief Recovery Support Group Begins Sunday, January 8th 6:30-8:30PM (in BUMC Fellowship Hall)

GRIEF

Have you recently lost a spouse, child, family member, or friend? You have probably found there are not many people who understand the deep hurt you feel. This can be a confusing time when you feel isolated and have questions about things you have never faced before. I, and many others, understand and would like to reach out to offer support through GriefShare.

What is GriefShare?

GriefShare is a thirteen-week program, focused on helping individuals learn how to understand their grief and move forward again. GriefShare groups meet weekly to help you face these challenges and move toward rebuilding your life. Each GriefShare session has three distinct elements:

Video Seminar with Experts:

Each week your GriefShare group will watch a video seminar featuring top experts on grief and recovery subjects. These videos are produced in an interesting-to-watch television magazine format featuring expert interviews, real-life case studies, dramatic reenactments, and on-location video. The video can be viewed at the group site, or online.

Support Group Discussion with Focus:

After viewing the video, you and the other group members will spend time as a support group, discussing what was presented in that week's video seminar and what is going on in your lives.

Workbook-based Personal Study and Reflection:

During the week you will have the opportunity to use your workbook for further personal study of the grieving process and to help sort out your emotions through journaling. Your group will spend time discussing questions and comments from the workbook study.

Participants are welcome to join the group at any time. If you miss a session, you will be able to "make it up" during the next 13-week cycle. Budget Results for November 2022

For the month of November, 2022, the Church Budget spent \$12,314.81 more than it received. For the year, the Church Budget received \$14,402.33 more than it spent.

<u>Major Maintenance & Repair Fund</u> – this designated money will be used to pay for major maintenance or repair projects to the Church building, parsonage or parking lot. The Board of Trustees must recommend all expenditures from this fund to the Church Council, and the Church Council must approve all expenditures from this fund. This is a perpetual fund and a minimum balance of \$2,500.00 shall be maintained at all times. \$92,419.89 MM&RF Money Available November 30, 2022

Other Designated Gifts – occurs when the Church receives money for a designated purpose and the Church shall only spend this money for the purpose that it was given.

\$101,800.00 Perpetual Care Cemetery Fund

In order to plan and provide the necessary funds for the care and upkeep of our cemetery, a Perpetual. Care Cemetery Fund was created. This fund was a non-expendable trust fund in which the principal (donations) cannot be spent but the interest earned on the principal can be spent for the care and upkeep of the cemetery. The Perpetual Care Cemetery Fund was capped as of November 17, 2016 by the Church Council and is no longer taking donations.

\$50,091.75 Helen Grady Endowment Fund

The money was donated to our church from the estate of Helen Grady in 2007 to be used for improvements to the church, community, or the development of an individual. The money is at the United Methodist Foundation of WNC, Inc. and the amount that can be spent annually is 5% of the last three (3) years average end-of-year balance.
