# **STEWARDSHIP REPORT-March 2024**

### Budget – Revenues & Expenses

\$522,785.45 Total Budget's Fund Balance as of March 1, 2024,

+ 25,578.26 Money Received in March

- 37,444.43 Money Spent in March (Finished paying for New Church Sign)

\$510,919.28 Budget's Fund Balance as of March 31, 2024

For the month of March, 2024, the Church Budget spent \$11,866.17 more than it received. For the year, the Church Budget spent \$22,356.49 more than it received.

### **Designated Gifts**

**Disaffiliation Loan Repayment**-The church council voted unanimously on October 22, 2023, to borrow the money needed to pay our disaffiliation expenses from the Designated Gifts Collective Fund Balance. The conference notified us on November 15, 2023, the disaffiliation amount was \$78,485.33.

<u>Major Maintenance & Repair Fund</u> – this designated money will be used to pay for major maintenance or repair projects to the Church building, parsonage or parking lot. The Board of Trustees must recommend all expenditures from this fund to the Church Council, and the Church Council must approve all expenditures from this fund. This is a perpetual fund and a minimum balance of \$2,500.00 shall be maintained at all times.

#### **Trust Funds**

### \$101,800.00 Perpetual Care Cemetery Fund

In order to plan and provide the necessary funds for the care and upkeep of our cemetery, a Perpetual Care Cemetery Fund was created. This fund was a non-expendable trust fund in which the principle (donations) cannot be spent but the interest earned on the principle can be spent for the care and upkeep of the cemetery. The Perpetual Care Cemetery Fund was capped as of September 17, 2016 by the Church Council and is no longer taking donations.

### \$60,054.76 Helen Grady Endowment Fund

The money was donated to our church from the estate of Helen Grady in 2007 to be used for improvements to the church, community, or the development of an individual. The money is at the United Methodist Foundation of WNC, Inc. and the amount that can be spent annually is 5% of the last three (3) years average end-of-year balance.
